The Pusser's Story

Pusser's Landing began as part of Charles Tobias' vision to bring the Royal Navy's rich naval rum tradition ashore. After launching Pusser's Rum commercially in 1979, the first Pusser's Landing restaurant opened in Soper's Hole, Tortola in the British Virgin Islands. The name pays tribute to the Royal Navy, where "Pusser" was slang for the ship's purser, the officer who issued the daily rum ration. With outposts in the BVIs, Germany, and the US, Pusser's Landing became a popular destination for sailors, locals, and tourists alike. After 30 years of food, fun and family on the Annapolis Harbor, we've landed here at Lighthouse Point Marina.
